Procedures

- All staff, parents and volunteers are made aware of our no-smoking policy.
- We display no-smoking signs.
- Parents/carers are made aware of our no smoking policy.
- Staff who smoke must smoke outside the setting perimeter and not near the entrance door.
- Staff who smoke during their break must make every effort to reduce the effect of the odour and lingering effects of passive smoking for children and colleagues.
- Staff who smoke must NOT leave their cigarette butts on the ground, they must be put in a rubbish bin safely.
