25. No-Smoking/Vaping.

Policy Statement

We comply with the 'Smoke-Free (Premises and Enforcement) Regulations 2006 in making our setting a no-smoking environment – both indoor and outdoor.

All forms of smoking including cigarettes, Vapes, pipes and cigars are included with in this policy.

Procedures

- All staff, parents/carers, volunteers and service users are made aware of our non-smoking policy (including Vapes).
- We display no-smoking signs.
- All staff, parents/carers, volunteers and service users who smoke must do so outside of the setting perimeter and not near the entrance door.
- All staff, parents/carers, volunteers and service users choosing to smoke during their breaks must make every effort to reduce the effect of the odour and lingering effects of passive smoking for children/young people and colleagues.
- All staff, parents/carers, volunteers and service users who smoke must NOT leave cigarette butts on the ground, they must be put in a rubbish bin safely.
