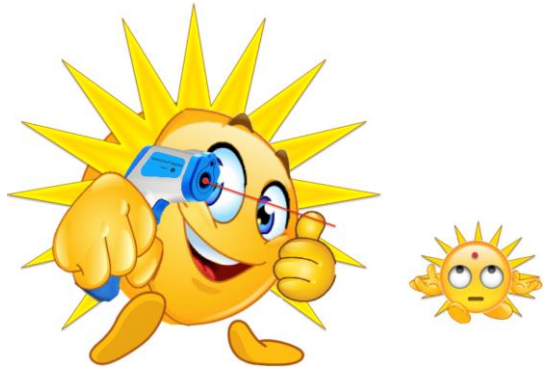


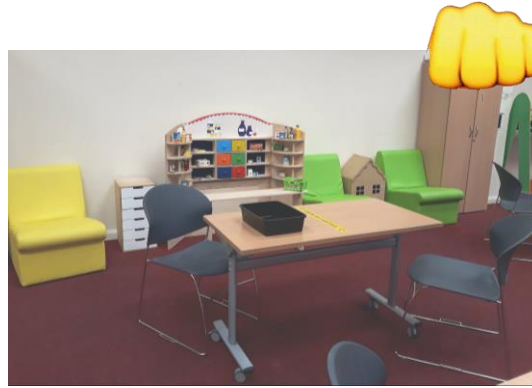
Coming to Sunbeams

Keeping Safe



For a while there will be fewer children and everyone will have their own play-worker. While you are at Sunbeams you must listen to your play-worker and follow instructions to keep us all safe and well.

This includes washing your hands, keeping a safe distance when playing and waiting your turn. Your play-worker will help you understand how to keep safe.

At the moment we can't use the sensory room as this is where all the toys are. Your play-worker will go in and get the toys you want to use. When you've finished playing with a toy it will be put on a table outside of the room and taken to be cleaned ready for someone else to use.

Distancing

You will see there are more tables in the room, this is so you can have your own space to play.

Look at the safety signs around Sunbeams and follow their guidance, if you're not sure ask your play-worker.



There will be a taped area to walk from outside and to the toilets and special circles to show you where you need to wait.

You also need to wash your hands regularly and with soap for 20 seconds or longer.

Your play-worker will help you understand how long this is and you can sing a song like happy birthday if it helps.

Coughs and Sneezes

Some of the staff or other children may want to wear a mask, this helps to keep everyone safe if they cough or sneeze but you don't have to wear one.



Just remember if you need to cough or sneeze cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve not your hand.

Put the tissue in the bin straight away and wash your hands with soap and water or use sanitiser.

You need to try and not touch your eyes, nose or mouth until you have washed your hands.
